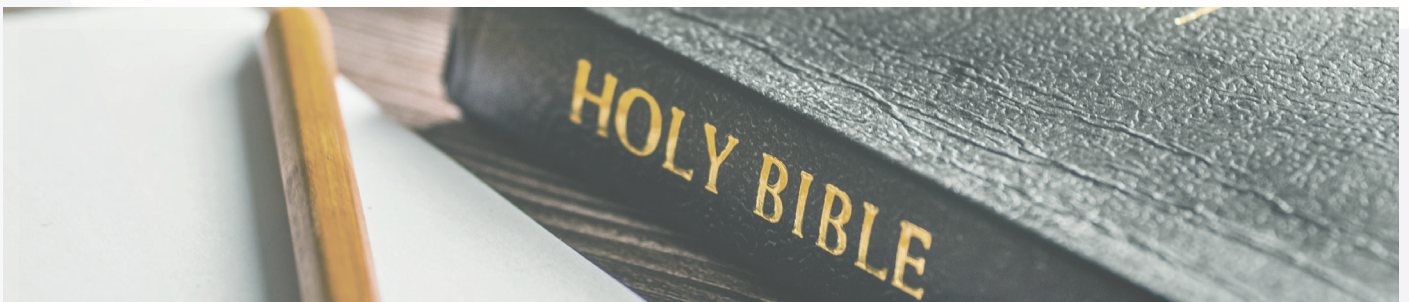

“In my early years, I felt little need to be trained in bible study and ministry, preferring to work in evangelism and support pastoral work instead. However, as time progressed, I was encouraged by other leaders to get further training, so I pursued biblical studies and other trainings.
